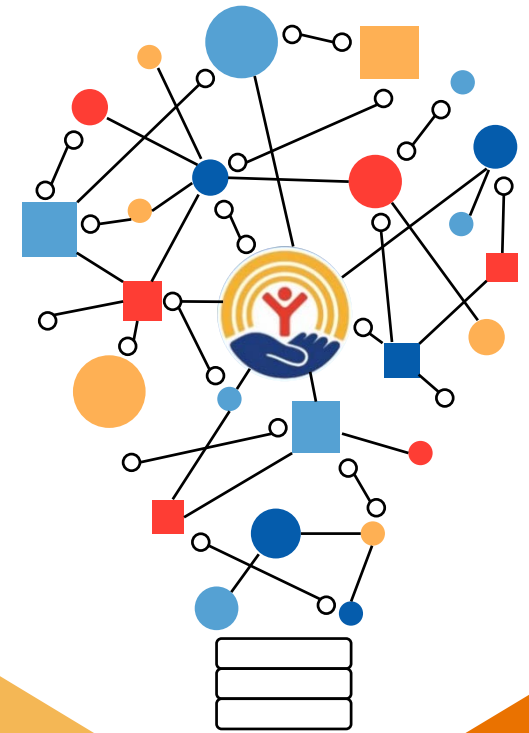
- For a family of 4, it takes approximately **\$56,000** dollars per year to meet the basic cost of living in this area.

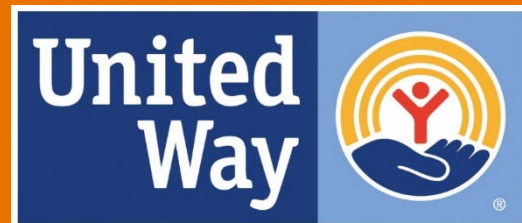

## What is Generation IMPACT?

Generation IMPACT is a group of young professionals with a common goal of **innovating modern Philanthropy** and **Community Transformation** in Volusia and Flagler Counties. Together, we have created a Social Innovation Fund with the hopes of achieving that goal in our community.

What is the Social Innovation Fund (SIF)? It provides **local high school, college, or vocational school students** with mini grants in order to implement innovative projects that address critical challenges in Flagler & Volusia counties.

If you have an **idea** for a project that will bring about positive social change in our community, apply for a Social Innovation Fund mini grant!

### Who Can Apply:

Individual or groups of **High School and College students** in Volusia or Flagler County



### SIF Proposal Requirements:

1. Projects must address issues in one of the following areas:
  - a) **Education:** Absenteeism, graduation rates, discipline, etc.
  - b) **Financial Stability:** Housing, income, access to good jobs, financial literacy- understanding credit, budgets, taxes, etc.
  - c) **Health:** Diabetes, injury prevention, opioid crisis, food insecurity, healthy living, exercise, community safety, etc.
2. Projects must work to improve the lives of **ALICE** families in Flagler and/or Volusia Counties. ALICE represents those who work hard and are above the poverty line, but due to high costs of living and factors often beyond their control, must live paycheck to paycheck.
3. Project proposals can be **Conceptual!**

Applications are open starting **Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>** and are due **Friday, November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019**. Select applicants will be invited to work with a mentor to create a full project proposal in January, 2020.
